All instructors receive comprehensive training on the program including training on the curriculum and assessment, student motivation program and managing student behavior prior to program implementation. Education Station's policy is to attempt to meet all state specifications related to hiring highly qualified instructors. At a minimum, instructors have degrees in related fields. Staff have experience working with students who are economically disadvantaged, from varied racial and ethnic groups, who have disabilities, and who have limited English proficiency.
